As of now it is a proposal that may take effect 7/1/24 for the aging and traumatic brain injury waivers. It will not affect CIH or PAC as of now; which is the services AID provides. With that being said CIH and PAC preferred caregiver services have been brought up and could be affected in the near future. AID understands the worry and frustration as we too are having the same emotions. I am encouraging everyone to submit a public comment or contact local officials.

This gives you the opportunity to let the state know your thoughts about this proposal and how it will affect your family and loved one. - An order form will soon be sent out with AID clothing and swag that you can purchase.






#### Announcement:
